- ◆ **Monday & Tuesday Morning:** Presentations on the different spiritualities within the Church's tradition and how we can live them, including a Q&A session.

### What is Taizé?

Taizé is an ecumenical community in France whose worship features meditative singing and periods of quiet reflection to help those gathered enter into a conversation with Christ and rest in His presence.
